LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS RULE 27-1.
 - a) Beyond all boundary fences marking the golf course and 'out of bound posts'.
 - b) When playing the 1st hole, beyond the line of white posts between the first and the 18th fairways over the burn.
 - c) When playing the 5th hole, beyond the line of white posts to the right and up to the 6th tee.
 - d) When playing the 18th hole, beyond the line of white posts to the right of the 18th fairway between the burn and up to the Clubhouse.
 - e) Beyond the high mesh fence to rear of 3rd green.

2. GROUND UNDER REPAIR RULE 25-1

All areas bounded by a white line. A ball lying in, or part of it touches the GUR, the ball may be dropped, without penalty no nearer the hole, to the NEAREST point of complete relief.

3. OVERHEAD WIRES

If a ball strikes an overhead power line within the bounds of the course, the stroke must be re-played without penalty.

NOTE: The pylons are an integral part of the course.

4. STONES IN BUNKERS

Are moveable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

5. PROTECTED TREES

All trees and shrubs marked with a band or staked are immovable obstructions. Rule 24-2 applies.

6. TRACTOR MARKS ON FAIRWAYS

May be treated as ground under repair. Rule 25 applies.

7. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:

If the ball lies off putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which: a) Is not nearer the hole b) Avoids such intervention and c) Is not in a hazard or on the putting green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES

Match play - Loss of hole Stroke play - Two strokes

9. SEEDED DIVOTS

Where a ball lies in or is touching a seeded divot, the ball must not be played and without penalty dropped within one club length, no nearer the hole.

10. PATHS

All paths with an artificial surface, including bark, are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be taken at the nearest point of relief under Rule 24-2. All other paths are integral paths of the course.
