### **PRESS RELEASE – BUSHEY HALL GOLF CLUB**

Bushey Hall Golf Club, the oldest golf course in Hertfordshire is to undergo extensive refurbishment to their course. UK based golf course architects PGA Design Consulting are advising the golf club on areas of improvement along with the requests and ideas from the existing members.

Massive capital is being poured into the golf club to improve the current standards. The club aspires to be the best course in Hertfordshire.

Over a five-year period PGADC have scheduled a programme of tree planting to take place to add to the already beautiful 120-acre wood and parkland golf course situated in the middle of Hertfordshire.

The club are installing a revolutionary water recycling system that will improve the sustainability of the golf course whilst increasing the opportunity for it to thrive in a period of drought. This system could well be a requirement for golf courses in the future to aid in creating a sustainable environment.

All greens are to receive soil amelioration using the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Aeration process in the form of the DryJect system. This system uses water to drill large holes in the green that can then be filled with virtually any soil amendment, whilst allowing the green to be back in play within hours. The Queenwood Golf Club recently endorsed the DryJect system with much success.

Immediate repairs to worn areas on the fairways and greens are being carried out by the greenstaff. Once this is completed, work will begin on all bunkers. The bunkers will be rebuilt to improve aesthetic appearance and playability.

The closely monitored work between Bushey Hall Golf Club and PGADC promise to make the course one of the best of its kind.
